Classroom Happenings

Virtual elementary has been working with the globe and land and water forms. Older students have been doing research on holidays and important dates. They enjoyed a presentation about Day of the Dead by Isaac's family.

Virtual 3-6 have been working on the parts of the plant and with their metal insets. Both virtual classes have been working on learning about peaceful choices and exploring works of art from famous artists.

In-person 3-6 learned to fold their clothes and started prickle practice. They also learned Christmas tree decorating (with much excitement) and are studying the Solar System.

In-person 6-9 is learning about biomes, noun phrases, and parts of a root. They did leaf art this week and will be exploring geometric solids soon.

9-12 learned about the election process during election week. Students finished reading a book of African stories and wrote their own Morality Tales to share with the 6-9 class. They are also practicing measuring angles with a protractor and classifying the types of triangles.

At Home Readiness

If your child is attending in-person classes, please check on your home work space now and get prepared for possible working from home. Though we hope you won't have to work from home due to quarantine, isolation, or lock down, we want to be as ready as possible.

To have a successful at-home school work experience, your child should have:

- a dedicated work space with a desk area and a rug work area
- a quiet space where no TV or other distractions are happening
- internet compatible device with wifi
- Zoom and Seesaw log in information
- working printer with ink refills ready
- printer paper, cardstock, construction paper in various colors, writing paper, drawing paper
- writing pencils, colored pencils, scissors, glue stick, (ruler for older children)

Quarantine Guidelines

This is a friendly reminder to alert DMS if your child or anyone in your household has been exposed to a confirmed Covid-19 case. Quarantining is required when exposure has been confirmed for 14 days from the date of exposure.
